Health insurance requirements	You are required to contract from your country a health insurance that covers sickness, accidents and repatriation. For European students, you need to bring the E U social security card
What type of housing does ICAM offer?	Each ICAM site has got a student housing.
How do students apply for housing?	The students should contact directly Catherine MAURY.
Deadline for housing arrangements.	Two months before your arrival.
Approximate housing cost per month	370 Euros a month in 2009/2010
Approximate cost of living per month	300/350 Euros depending on the town you are in during your stay
Is there a pick up service?	Yes. Tutors (ICAM students) will pick you up at the airport or at the railway station, but you have to confirm your arrival (flight number, airline, date and hour) at least two weeks before your arrival.
