



SUMMER PROGRAM IN FRANCE

JUNE /JULY 2009

A European Summer program in **Toulouse**, located in the South West of France, right in the heart of the aeronautical industry territory.



The program was initially designed for engineering students.

The full program lasts 8 weeks :

4 weeks to take French classes, to become better acquainted with Europe , its traditions and institutions, the differences between European countries and their ways of life and to have a taste of French engineering studies(for those who take engineering at home), plus 4 weeks of internship in local industry.

The program :

From June 2nd to June 26th :

- **Intensive French language Course (48 Hours)**
- **« Understanding Europe as a diverse entity » (36 Hours)**
 - Aims of the course:
 - To examine European stereotypes by analysis and comparison to other countries stereotypes. To acquire a rich bank of information in order to stimulate a personal and common ideology about Europe.
 - To improve your presentation skills by giving a short expose on the European capital of your choice.
 - To be able to participate in meaningful debates about Europe.
 - To improve your understanding of French using texts and audio supports.
- **Lab Work for engineering students (6 to 12 hours)**
- **Cultural visits (Toulouse & Carcassonne); Company visits .**



From June 29th to July 24th:

4 weeks of Internship in a company accompanied by one of our ICAM students.

Main Features :

The students attending the full program may get credits (up to half the semester's credits you can get at home).

The internship is designed to experience work in a firm and their different methods of organization. French students from ICAM participate as their internship is mandatory: they are asked to work at least 4 weeks as an operator.

Accommodation is provided in a gated student residence, close to the campus; the students attending the summer programs have a individual room (with shower & toilet) in apartments (7 students max.), with cooking facilities and internet access. A student restaurant is open for lunch-time meals on the campus.

Week -ends are free for travel, except the first one where there is an organized excursion.

Cost of the Program in 2009 :

Full Program (8 weeks): 1900 Euros

The cost includes all accommodation while in France, subsistence, visits, local transportation.

It does not include: airfare, personal expenses (free week-ends, etc.), insurance, passport fees, home university fees & costs, tuition fees for students of Universities with no exchange program agreement with ICAM
